# Getting Started

---

*"Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor. If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up!" - Ecclesiastes 4:9-10*

This toolkit gives you everything you need to start a small accountability group with other men. Whether it is 3 brothers or 12, the principles are the same: show up, be real, and point each other to Christ.

## Group Guidelines

- Keep the group between 3-6 men for depth and trust
- Meet weekly or biweekly, same time, same place
- What is shared in the group stays in the group (strict confidentiality)
- No judgment, no fixing, just listening and praying
- Be consistent. Show up even when you do not feel like it

# Meeting Template (60 Minutes)

---

## Opening (5 minutes)

- Open in prayer
- One member shares a brief scripture or devotional thought

## Check-In Round (20 minutes)

- Each man answers: "How are you really doing this week?" (not the Sunday morning answer)
- One word to describe your week, then expand if you want

## Accountability Questions (20 minutes)

Go around and honestly answer:

- Have you been in the Word and prayer consistently this week?
- Have you been honest in all your dealings this week?
- Have you given priority to your family this week?
- Have you viewed any inappropriate content this week?
- Have you been a good steward of your finances this week?
- Is there anything you need to confess or get off your chest?

## Prayer and Close (15 minutes)

- Share specific prayer requests
- Pray for each other by name
- Confirm next meeting date and time

# Covenant Agreement

---

As a member of this accountability group, I commit to the following:

## **I Will Be Present**

I will prioritize this group and attend consistently. If I cannot make it, I will communicate in advance.

## **I Will Be Honest**

I will answer questions truthfully, even when it is uncomfortable. Growth happens in the light, not in the dark.

## **I Will Be Confidential**

What is shared in this group stays in this group. Period. Trust is the foundation of brotherhood.

## **I Will Be Supportive**

I will not judge, criticize, or gossip about my brothers. I will encourage, challenge, and pray for them.

## **I Will Be Accountable**

I give my brothers permission to ask me hard questions and to call me out in love when I am off track.
